To provide a forum within the European chemical measurement community for pursuing excellence in the development and implementation of proficiency testing (PT).

TERMS OF REFERENCE

- To improve the organisation of PT in Europe and abroad.
- To promote best practice in PT using appropriate mechanisms such as publications, workshops etc.
- To provide a forum for organisers and users of PT schemes on issues affecting the practice of PT.
- To organise, on a periodic basis, an international workshop on PT in analytical chemistry, microbiology and laboratory medicine.
- To provide input and disseminate output between Eurachem and the EA/Eurolab/Eurachem Working Group on PT in Accreditation (EEE-PT WG).
- To collaborate and provide input on PT into other Eurachem WGs.
- To provide input into international activities related to PT.

CURRENT ACTIVITIES

- Organisation of the 10th International Workshop on PT in Analytical Chemistry, Microbiology and Laboratory Medicine, in collaboration with EQALM and CITAC - Windsor (UK) 12-15 October 2020.
- Preparation and translation of a series of information leaflets regarding topics of interest to PT, to encourage good practice across Europe.
- Reviewing the evaluation of qualitative results in PT schemes.


